A SAD FAREWELL



Together with a huge number of residents of Tibshelf, and users, the Parish Council are devastated over the closure of Exercise4All.

This hugely popular facility became a life line for many people over a long period of time

Despite many hours of hard work and the valiant attempts of a small group of trustees and volunteers, and valuable support from Bolsover District Council, it appears that the possibility of an early re opening has been dashed. There was a real hope at one point that it may be possible to get the doors re-opened under the new name of Tibshelf Community Gym with a true Tibshelf Community effort comprising financial support from a number of individuals, the Parish Council, tradesmen who were prepared to give their labour free of charge and a number of professional people who became involved and were willing to become trustees.

However - the mountain of problems left behind have unfortunately now proved insurmountable.

The Parish Council have expressed their commitment to consider ways in which they can support either this, or the establishment of a similar sustainable facility, within the community, and to partner any other bodies who can work together to make this happen.
