

**Meeting of TIBSHELF PARISH held on
TUESDAY 16 MAY 2023 in the Council meeting room at 7pm**

DRAFT MINUTES

Present: Cllrs A Beckett, Cllr Jones, Cllr Kingscott, Cllr Gilbody, Cllr Varney, Cllr Ward, Cllr Foley and Cllr Wood.

In attendance: R Tattershaw (Parish Clerk), M Scarborough (Communications & Projects Officer) and 5 members of the public.

Apologies: Cllr Heffer, Cllr Watkinson and Cllr Barron.

1 Appointment of Chair to the meeting.

It was proposed by Cllr Wood, seconded by Cllr Kingscott and resolved unanimously to elect Cllr Beckett as Chair to the meeting.

2 Appointment of Clerk to the meeting

It was resolved unanimously the Parish Clerk would clerk the meeting.

3 To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 18 May 2022.

It was proposed by Cllr Wood, seconded by Cllr Kingscott and resolved unanimously to approve the minutes of the 18 May 2022 meeting.

4 Annual budget and precept for the financial year April 2023 to March 2024.

The Clerk confirmed the following precept information:

- a) The 2023/24 precept was set at £179,488.00.
- b) This year's precept was a 12% increase from 2022/23.
- c) The precept had not previously been increased since 2020/21.
- d) This increase in precept would increase the annual household amount by £14.94 = 0.29p per week.

The following Council events have been budgeted for in 2023/24:

- a) King Charles Coronation
- b) Remembrance Sunday parade
- c) Firework display
- d) Youth activities - Extreme Wheels throughout the school holidays.
- e) Carol service.
- f) Christmas light switch on event.

5. Annual Report

Cllr Beckett read out the Annual Report that will be published in the next Parish Council newsletter.

6. To consider any other Parish matter that may be brought forward by the Council or local government electors.

It was raised that the proposed double yellow lines on Back Lane will cause parking issues for carers and nurses visiting residents needing support living in the bungalows. It was agreed the Clerk would raise this concern with Cllr Barron.

A representative from Tibshelf First Responders requested an update on their donation request for supporting the King Charles event. The Clerk confirmed this was on the Annual Council meeting agenda.

A representative from The Green Bunch requested the Parish Council encourage more involvement with local groups.

It was raised that some residents felt they had a lack of information on the Neighbourhood Plan at the recent referendum. It was agreed the Clerk would include further communication with residents on the agenda for the next Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group meeting to be held on the 23rd May 2023.
