**To consider a letter received from Tibshelf Football Club requesting permission to place a 30ft metal container for storage purposes on the old car track site at the Shetland Road Playing Field.**

It was moved by Cllr Watkinson, seconded by Cllr Jones and unanimously **resolved** to grant Tibshelf Football Club permission to site a 30ft container on the Shetland Road playing field on behalf of Tibshelf Parish Council in order to support community recreation under the following conditions:

1. It is to be used to store all football club related items – no use of the pavilion for storage.
2. It is to be painted in green anti-climb paint.
3. It is to be fitted with appropriate signage.

The Clerk is to write to the Football Club informing of the above decision and that any further incidences of equipment being placed on the playing field or within the pavilion premises without permission will result in a refusal and order for removal.

A vote was taken: 8 in favor, 2 abstentions.

Councillors also requested the Clerk include within the letter that they are saddened to receive complaints from parents that their children have been refused access to training with the football club.
