

Neighbourhood Plan Meeting Notes  
20/09/2023

Members present:

There were no declarations of interest.

The Notes of the meeting of 18th August 2022 were approved: Moved Sue. Seconded Simon.

After further consultation with Andrew Towlerton it was agreed that the policy re Climate Change and Renewable Energy be not included as this was adequately covered in the District Plan. Moved by Simon, seconded by Barrie. Agreed unanimously.

**Consultation Statement (now part of the Supporting Evidence Documents library).**

All points we agreed at the last meet (18 Aug) have been included including the above.

We've received a response from Bolsover and they have no concerns about the Plan so now we can now go ahead and produce a Basic Conditions Statement (Andrew Towlerton is formulating).

**The Plan**

All alterations to the Plan after responses from the consultees have been made, namely:

- i) Removal of all references to HS2
- ii) Adjustment of maps to make site names and features clearer
- iii) Site names added to one policy (ENV4)

**Supporting Evidence Documents**

TNP02 Green Spaces: change to copy because of National Planning Policy Framework changes.

TNP13 Strategic Environmental Assessment Report : responses from consultees were added.

It was agreed that copies of the Plan and Supporting Evidence Documents will be distributed to all Councillors on Wednesday 21 September for them to digest before their meeting on Tuesday 27 Sept where they are requested to approve them to enable us to electronically submit to Bolsover District Council.

Copies of relevant changes will be emailed to all SG members.

**Timescale:**

For information purposes, Simon Haddock informed the meeting that submission to BDC will hopefully be on Wednesday 28 September which will start the six week long Regulation 16 Period and the appointment of an examiner.

After approval by the examiner (probably with minor changes) this will trigger a four week notification of a Referendum.

Proposed Ivan, Seconded by Simon. Unanimous decision to submit to PC for approval to enable submission to BDC.

The meeting agreed that a date and time for the next meeting could not be arranged until other procedures/responses have been carried out/received.
